The owner Luca Spensieri sent a letter to the Zoning Board requesting a Public Rehearing so that they might present a more detailed and comprehensive explanation of the project to the Board and public with a revised design and layout. Attorney Aikman read the letter to the Board members (letter is on file).

Chairman Lambros explained to the Board members that in order for Primo Sports to be granted a Public Rehearing the voting would have to be unanimous.
