COMMENTS:

- 1. What type of fence is specified around the solar panels? A rustic, farm type fence would be great, such as split rail.
- 2. The panels need screening on all sides. The screening should be only as high as the panels, which I assume are 10' or less. If this assumption is correct, a thick growing shrub such as Forsythia is fine. Forsythias should be planted at 5-6' in height, spaced 4' apart. Another species, such as Silky Dogwood, Cornus amonum. should be planted in middle sections, just in case a disease or insect attacks the Forsythias. The silky Dogwoods can be planted at 24-30" in height, spaced 4' apart.
