AGREEMENT between the Town Superintendent of the Town of Chester, Orange County, New York, and the undersigned members of the Town Board.

Pursuant to the provision of Section 284 of the Highway Law, we agree that money levied and collected in the Town for repair and improvement of highways, and received from the State Aid for the repair and improvement of highways, shall be expended as follows:

- 1) **GENERAL REPAIRS:** The sum of \$ 196,031.78 shall be set aside to be expended for primary work and general repairs upon 95.28 miles of town highways, including sluices, culverts, guide rails and bridges having a span of less than five feet of the renewals thereof.
- 2) **PERMANENT IMPROVEMENTS:** The following sums shall be set aside to be expended for the permanent improvement of town highways:
 - a) On the road commencing at Dawn Ct. and leading to Jeffrey Dr., a distance of .05 miles, there shall be expended the approximate sum of \$ 12,408.00 for (type of work) 1 1/2" milling and repaving. The width of the traveled surface is 30 feet. The thickness is 1 1/2" thick and the sub base is Slurry Seal.
 - b) On the road commencing at Jackie Ct. and leading to Jeffrey Dr., a distance of .08 miles, there shall be expended the approximate sum of \$ 19,852.80 for (type of work) 1 1/2" milling and repaving. The width of the traveled surface is 30 feet. The thickness is 1 1/2" thick and the sub base is Slurry Seal.
 - c) On the road commencing at Jeffrey Drive and leading to Kings Highway, a distance of .41 miles, there shall be expended the approximate sum of \$ 101,745.60 for (type of work) 1 1/2" milling and repaving. The width of the traveled surface is 30 feet. The thickness is 1 1/2" thick and the sub base is Slurry Seal.
 - d) On the road commencing at Jennifer Lane and leading to Jeffrey Dr., a distance of .06 miles, there shall be expended the approximate sum of \$ 14,889.60 for (type of work) 1 1/2" milling and repaving. The width of the traveled surface is 30 feet. The thickness is 1 1/2" thick and the sub base is Slurry Seal.

- e) On the road commencing at Laura Drive and leading to Jeffrey Dr., a distance of .16 miles, there shall be expended the approximate sum of \$ 39,705.60 for (type of work) 1 1/2" milling and repaving. The width of the traveled surface is 30 feet. The thickness is 1 1/2" thick and the sub base is Slurry Seal.
- f) On the road commencing at Adams Ct. and leading to Lincoln Rd., a distance of .08 miles, there shall be expended the approximate sum of \$ 3,011.40 for (type of work) Oil and Chip. The width of the traveled surface is 30 feet. The thickness is 1/4" thick and the sub base is Chip Seal.
- g) On the road commencing at Grant Drive and leading to Washington Dr., a distance of .26 miles, there shall be expended the approximate sum of \$ 6,978.80 for (type of work) Oil and Chip. The width of the traveled surface is 30 feet. The thickness is 1/4" thick and the sub base is Chip Seal.
- h) On the road commencing at Harding Way and leading to Jefferson Dr., a distance of .21 miles, there shall be expended the approximate sum of \$ 6,692.00 for (type of work) Oil and Chip. The width of the traveled surface is 30 feet. The thickness is 1/4" thick and the sub base is Chip Seal.
- i) On the road commencing at Harrison Place and leading to Lincoln Rd., a distance of .08 miles, there shall be expended the approximate sum of \$ 2,093.64 for (type of work) Oil and Chip. The width of the traveled surface is 30 feet. The thickness is 1/4" thick and the sub base is Chip Seal.
- j) On the road commencing at Hoover Ct. and leading to Wilson Rd., a distance of .04 miles, there shall be expended the approximate sum of \$ 2,509.50 for (type of work) Oil and Chip. The width of the traveled surface is 30 feet. The thickness is 1/4" thick and the sub base is Chip Seal.

- k) On the road commencing at Jefferson Dr. and leading to Lakes Rd., a distance of .29 miles, there shall be expended not over the sum of \$ 7,112.64 for (type of work) Oil and Chip. The width of the traveled surface is 30 feet. The thickness is 1/4" thick and the sub base is Chip Seal.
- l) On the road commencing at Lincoln Rd. and leading to Washington Rd., a distance of .48 miles, there shall be expended not over the sum of \$ 13,384.00 for (type of work) Oil and Chip. The width of the traveled surface is 30 feet. The thickness is 1/4" thick and the sub base is Chip Seal.
- m) On the road commencing at Madison Circle and leading to Wilson Rd., a distance of .27 miles, there shall be expended not over the sum of \$ 7,289.50 for (type of work) Oil and Chip. The width of the traveled surface is 30 feet. The thickness is 1/4" thick and the sub base is Chip Seal.
- n) On the road commencing at Tyler Place and leading to Lincoln Rd., a distance of .09 miles, there shall be expended not over the sum of \$ 2,509.50 for (type of work) Oil and Chip. The width of the traveled surface is 30 feet. The thickness is 1/4" thick and the sub base is Chip Seal.
- o) On the road commencing at Washington Rd. and leading to Lakes Rd., a distance of .54 miles, there shall be expended not over the sum of \$ 15,057.00 for (type of work) Oil and Chip. The width of the traveled surface is 30 feet. The thickness is 1/4" thick and the sub base is Chip Seal.
- p) On the road commencing at Wilson Rd. and leading to Lincoln Rd., a distance of .48 miles, there shall be expended not over the sum of \$ 12,246.36 for (type of work) Oil and Chip. The width of the traveled surface is 30 feet. The thickness is 1/4" thick and the sub base is Chip Seal.

q) On the road commencing at Lily Pond Rd. and leading to Lakes Rd., a distance of .51 miles, there shall be expended the approximate sum of \$ 14,942.28 for (type of work) Oil and Chip. The width of the traveled surface is 30 feet. The thickness is 1/4" thick and the sub base is Chip Seal.
