WHEREAS, on February 14, 2024 the Town of Chester resolved to adopt the Climate Smart Communities pledge;

WHEREAS, the Town of Chester considers the New York State Climate Smart Communities initiative to be a valuable framework to help the Town increase environmental sustainability and lead the community by example; the Town of Chester wishes to obtain certification under the Climate Smart Communities Program.

WHEREAS, establishing a Climate Smart Communities Task Force is a mandated action in the Climate Smart Communities certification program;
