(2) Electro-Voice ZLX-15P  
15" powered loudspeakers  
1000 W (Class D); 127 dB max SPL; 42 Hz – 20 kHz  
15" woofer and 1.5" high-frequency titanium compression driver

Both speakers on stage, where bands set them, outputting sound at a minimum average of 87dB(A) or greater for reading recording purposes. An internet search gives "Welcome to the Jungle" by Guns N Roses as one of the loudest songs recorded so that was utilized for recording purposes.
